

YOU HAVE A RIGHT TO PRIVACY ABOUT YOUR PREGNANCY

- The HIPAA "Privacy Rule" protects your confidential pregnancy information from being disclosed. This includes information about a pregnancy, stillbirth, miscarriage, abortion, or other pregnancy outcomes.
- In most cases, a state abortion ban does **not** allow your health information to be shared with law enforcement.
- If someone shares your confidential pregnancy information with law enforcement, you have a right to file a complaint with the HHS Office for Civil Rights.
- In our facility, we will treat your personal information as private.
