Endoscopic findings

Major upper-GI endoscopic findings:

- Erosive esophagitis
- Eosinophilic esophagitis
- Erosive gastritis
- Esophageal varices
- Portal hypertensive gastropathy
- Esophageal stenosis
- Esophageal cancer
- Gastric peptic ulcer
- Gastric polyps
- Gastric cancer
- Barrett's esophagus
- Erosive duodenitis
- Duodenal peptic ulcer
- Duodenal stenosis
- Complicated coeliac disease
- Angiodysplasia
- Atrophy

Minor upper-GI endoscopic findings:

- Non-erosive gastritis
- Hiatal hernia
- Non-erosive duodenitis
- Gastritis-resected stomach

Major lower GI endoscopic findings:

- Adenocarcinoma
- Advanced lesion °
- **≥3 adenomas**
- Active IBD
- Complicated diverticular disease
- Ischemic colitis
- Hemorroid
- Angiodysplasia
- Post-polipectomy bleeding
- Stenosis

° Advanced lesion = adenomas ≥ 10 mm in size, or with HGD, or T-V features; or significant serrated polyps defined as size ≥ 10 mm or with dysplasia e.g. traditional serrated adenomas

Minor lower-GI endoscopic findings:

- 1 or 2 adenomas < 10 mm
- Sessile serrated polyp < 10 mm (no dysplasia)
- Hyperplastic
- Quiescent IBD
- Uncomplicated diverticular disease
