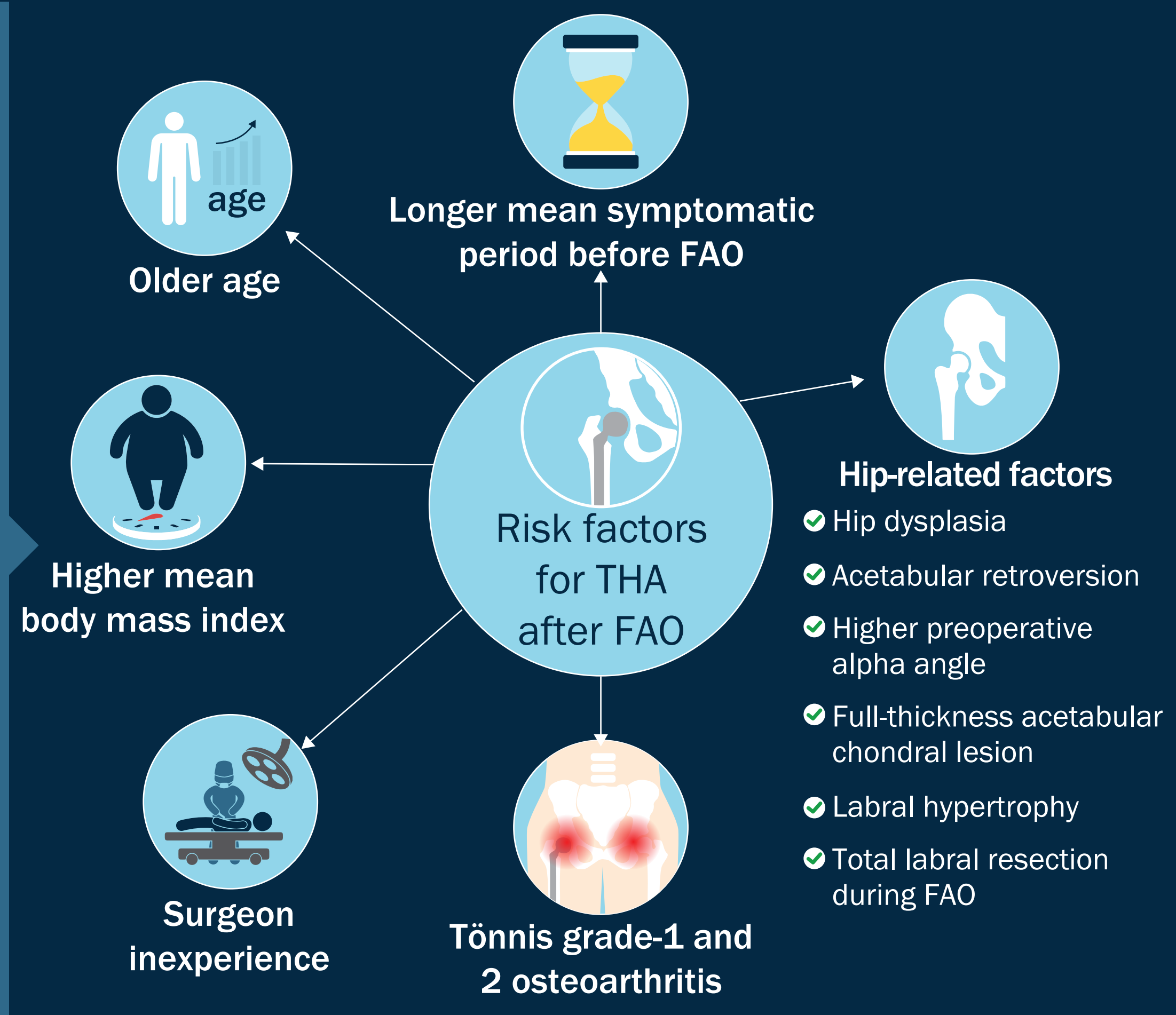
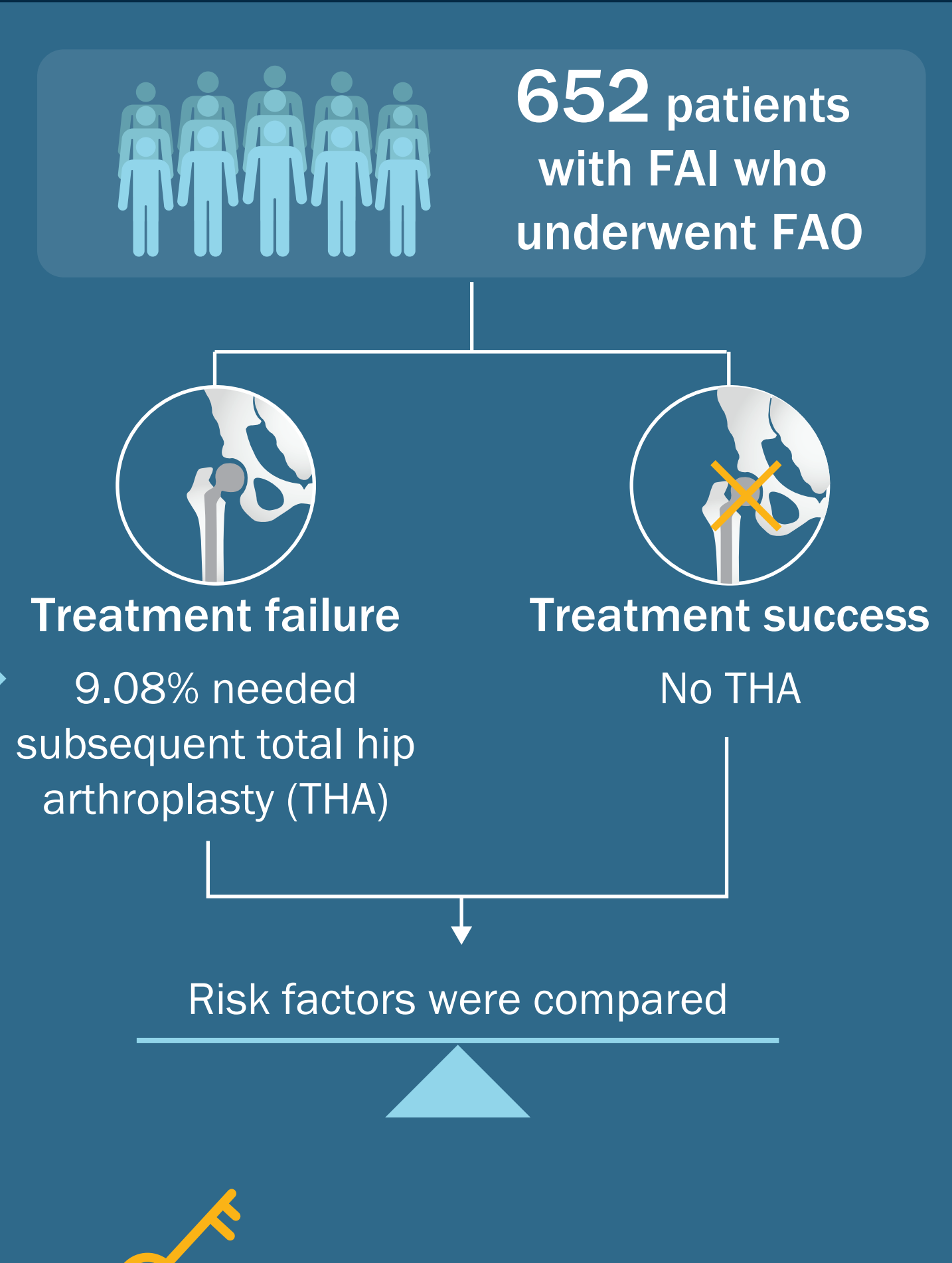


Risk Factors for Failure of Hip Preservation Surgery in Femoroacetabular Impingement

Symptoms of femoroacetabular impingement (FAI) are increasingly being surgically managed via hip-preserving femoroacetabular osteoplasty (FAO)



However, the risk factors for the failure of FAO are unclear



A number of variables negatively affect the outcome after FAO, necessitating subsequent THA
