#### RESEARCH IN PROGRESS

Mixed methods: faculty perspectives of teaching and facilitating learning transfer in VBSN programs

Longitudinal multi-intervention, multi-method pilot study: **effectiveness of timed digital interventions on workshop participants’** integration of veteran specific content into their curricula

Conceptualization stage, narrative methodology: military nurse leaders and their influence on the profession after a career of service in the military
