## **Supplemental Methods**

Criteria for Special Cause Variation

As per the recommendations in Carey et al<sup>1</sup>, special cause variation was considered to have been met when any of the following conditions occurred:

- When a single point falls outside of the control limit
- A trend of 6 or more values in a row steadily increasing or decreasing
- When two out of three successive values are: a) on the same side of the centerline, and b) more than 2 standard deviations from the centerline
- When eight or more successive values fall on the same side of the centerline
