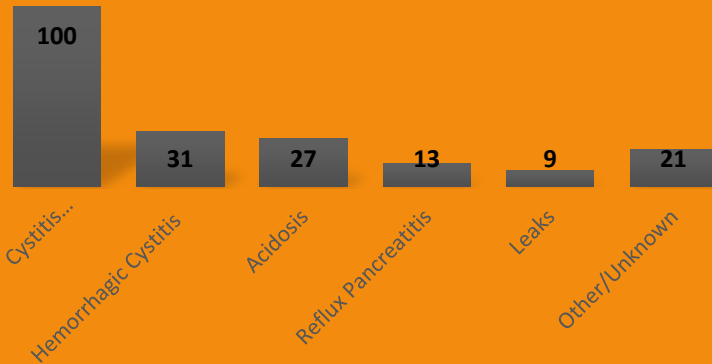


Enteric Conversion of Bladder Drained Pancreas as a Predictor of Outcomes in almost 600 Recipients at a Single-Center

We studied the association between enteric conversion and the pancreas graft rejection, loss and mortality

Multivariate Cox PH models were utilized while treating conversion as a time-dependent covariate separate models were used to assess timing of conversion

70 Simultaneous Pancreas-Kidney Recipients

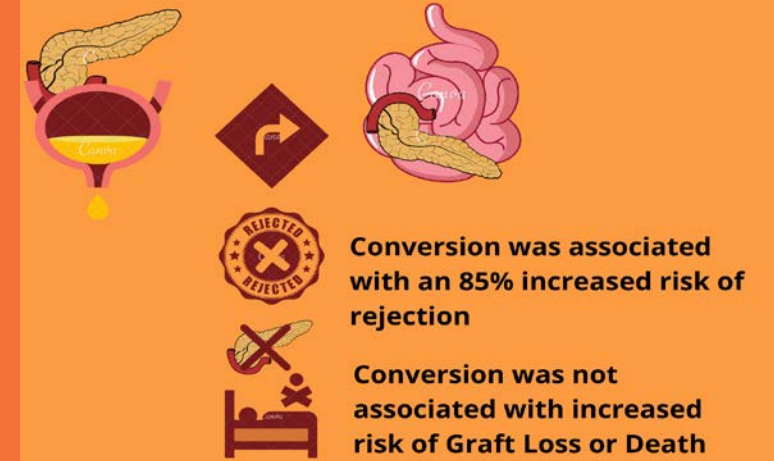

Later conversion was associated with an 18% less Rejection and a 22% better Graft Survival
